Production: rehearsals for a new production with premiere in 2023/2024.

Rehearsals: for festivals, guest performances, etc.

Research: methodical or conceptual **Development of own artistic practice:** for proposals independent of any project

Open to projects from the fields of:

- Dance/Choreography
- Interdisciplinarity/performance with a core connection to dance
- Dance education and cultural education with a focus on dance

- Opportunity for a self-organized presentation.
- Possibility for a dialogue with other artists about the development and perspective of the work.

SELECTION PROCESS

The criteria for selection are the artistic vision, the intention for the residency, the possibilities to develop a connection with the house, the viability of the project in our space and the thorough application.

An important factor in the decision is to create a balanced program that encompasses a variety of themes and intentions, as well as supporting artists at different stages of their careers. It is also essential for us to promote sustainability in artistic biographies, therefore we need to understand how the project relates to this. Moreover, we are interested in what you would like to do concretely during the residency, for example if the idea consists of several phases and you want to realize only one of them in Quartier am Hafen.

We prioritize artists and groups who are based in Cologne.

The selection for the next season will be made by Angie Hiesl and Silvia Ehnis Perez Duarte. The decision will be communicated at the end of May.
